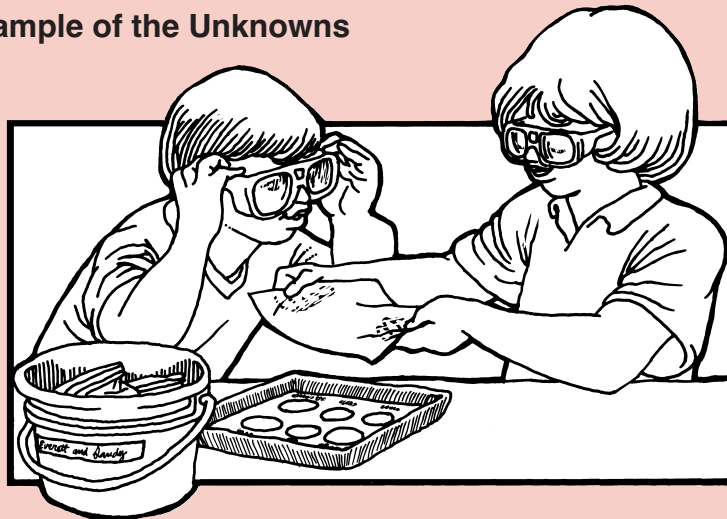


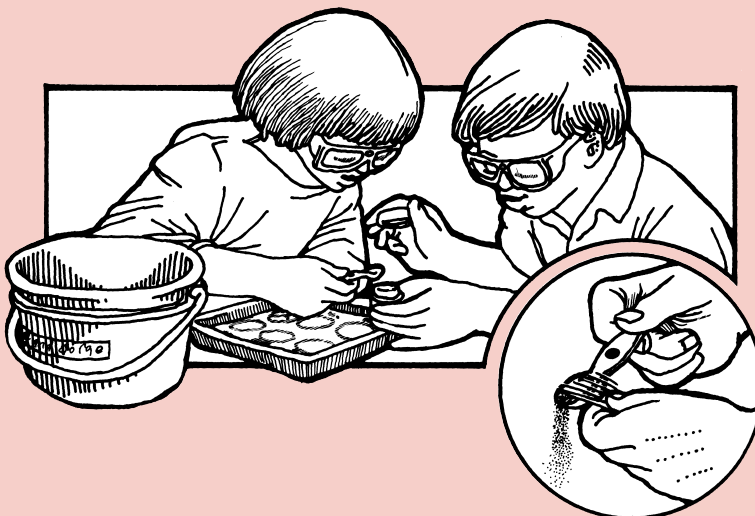
Student Instructions for Taking a Sample of the Unknowns

1. Put on your goggles. Set up your tray with the test mat (use the side with the color names on it) and put the wax paper on top of the test mat.



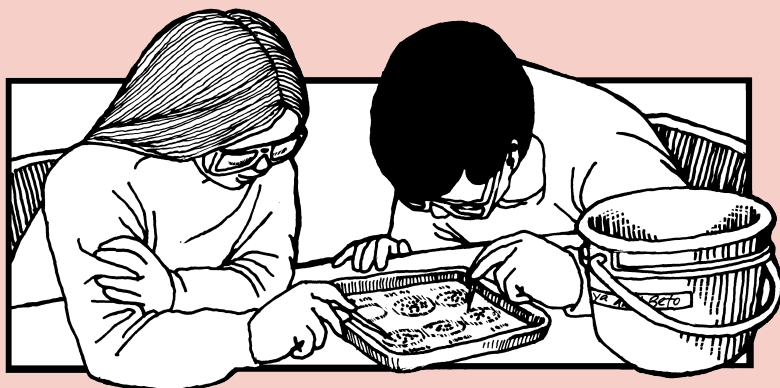
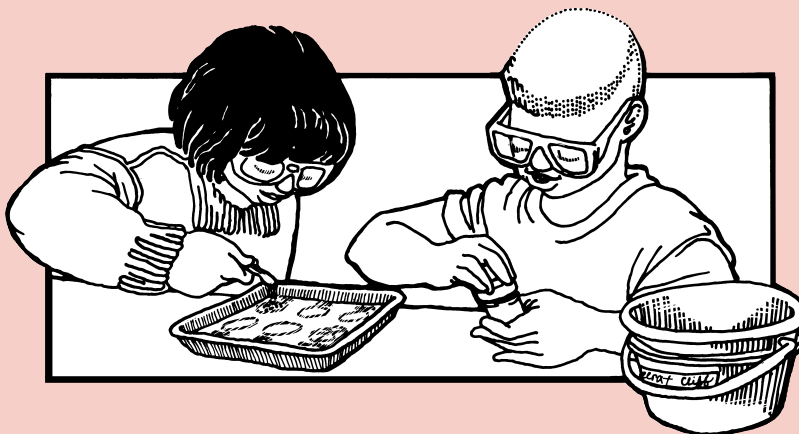
2. Take out the red unknown sample jar and red measuring spoon. Open the jar.

3. Take one measure of the red unknown. Use your toothpick to level the amount on the spoon.



4. Put the sample on the red circle on your test mat.

5. Wipe off the spoon with a paper towel. Put the closed jar and spoon back in your science pail.



6. Observe the red unknown. Repeat Steps 2 through 6 with the four other unknowns.
